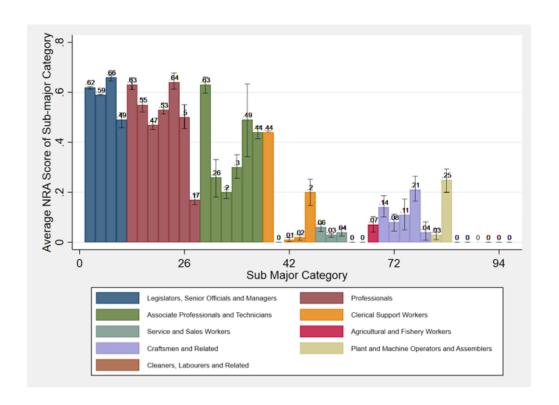


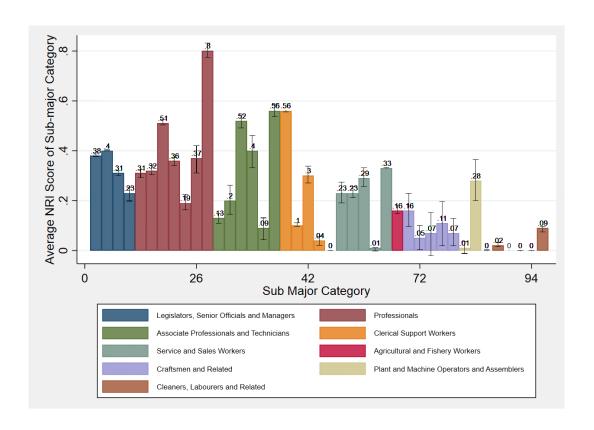


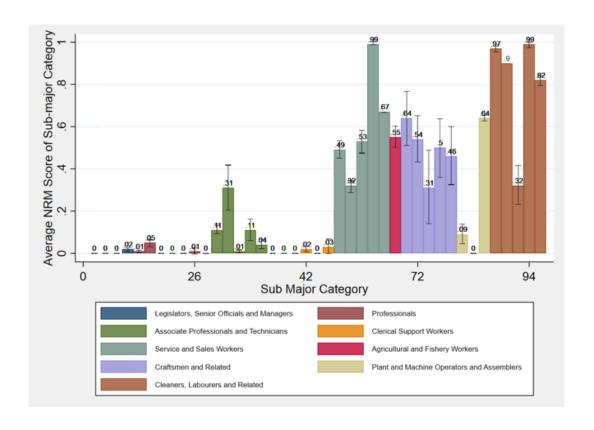


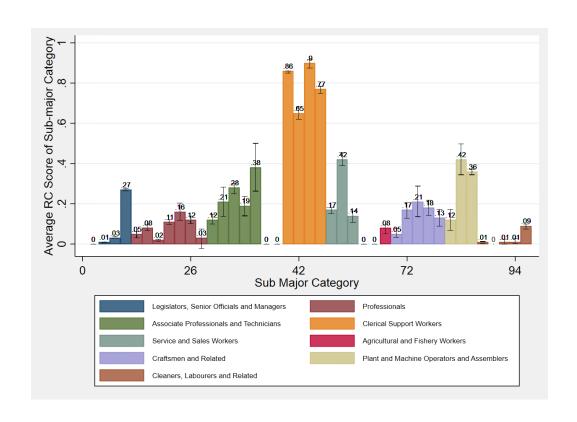


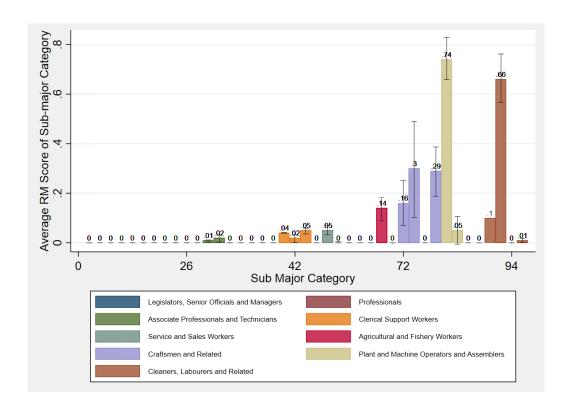




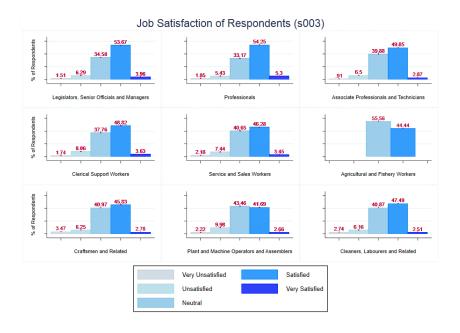


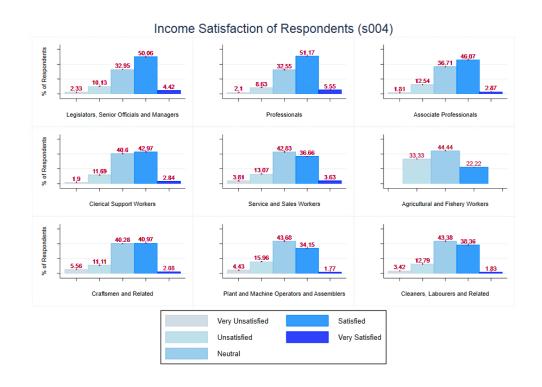


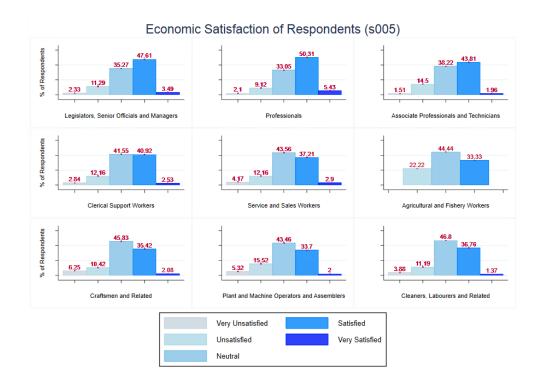




APPENDIX 3: DISTRIBUTIONS OF RESPONDENTS BY WELL-BEING RESPONSE CATEGORY
